

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE  
TOWN OF BAYSIDE, TEXAS, TO CHANGE THE  
NAME OF A STREET AND TO REQUIRE A PETITION  
TO THE COUNCIL FROM THE QUALIFIED VOTERS  
OF THE TOWN OF BAYSIDE TO CHANGE ANY  
STREET NAME IN THE FUTURE.

Whereas a formal request has been made to the Town Council  
to change the name of Klan Street,  
And whereas the Council has voted to grant this change.  
And whereas the Council has expressed concern over the  
possibility of possible name change request in the future;  
Be it ordained by the Town Council of the Town of Bayside,  
Texas:

SECTION I:

The street known as Klan St. that was named by ordinance  
No. 10, dated Nov. 28, 1978, shall be changed to  
Mitchell Drive. This name shall be effective immediate-  
ly and should be placed on all maps effective immediate-  
ly.

SECTION II:

Any street name change after approval of this ordinance  
will require a petition bearing the signature of (2/3)  
two-thirds of the qualified voters in the Town of Bay-  
side. Such petition should then be presented to the  
Town Council for action on the matter.

SECTION III:

All ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict with  
this ordinance are hereby repealed.

SECTION IV:


If any section or provision or part thereof, in this  
ordinance, shall be adjudged invalid or unconstitutional  
by any court of competent jurisdiction, such application  
shall not affect the validity of this ordinance as a  
whole or any section or provision thereof, not adjudged  
invalid or unconstitutional.

SECTION V:


This ordinance is hereby declared an emergency and a public necessity, and said rules are hereby suspended and this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and it is so enacted.

All existing maps and records pertaining to the Town of Bayside shall be changed to reflect this new name as listed in Section I of this ordinance.
