

ORDINANCE NO. 27

AN ORDINANCE TO INCREASE THE EFFECTIVE PROPERTY TAX RATE FOR THE TOWN OF BAYSIDE, COUNTY OF REFUGIO, STATE OF TEXAS, BY 100% FROM THE 1985 TAX RATE OF .14385 TO .28770 PER (100) ONE HUNDRED DOLLARS OF ASSESSED VALUE.

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council having fully complied with the regulations as set forth in Article VIII, Section 21, 26.04, 26.05 and 26.06 of Vernons Civil Statutes:

TO WIT: the proposal of tax increase was discussed as an agenda item during the meeting of July 15, 1985;

TO WIT: Notice of the Public Hearing was posted and published on July 18, 1985:

TO WIT: the Public Hearing was held on Tuesday, July 30, 1985:


TO WIT: the notice of intent to vote on tax increase was posted and published on August 1, 1985:

TO WIT: a meeting was held on August 5, 1985 to vote on said tax increase, and did vote to increase said taxes as specified herein;

THEREFORE, be it ordained by the Board of Aldermen of the Town of Bayside that the effective tax rate for all property located within the city limits be .28770 per (100) one hundred dollars assessed evaluation for the tax year 1986, and that the exemptions from the tax year of 1985 will remain unchanged and shall apply to the tax year 1986.

THEREFORE, that upon written request of the Mayor or five Council members, copy attached, to find and declare an emergency due to the need for efficient and effective administration of City affairs such finding of an emergency is made and declared requiring suspension of the Charter rule as to consideration and voting upon ordinances or resolutions at three regular meetings so that this ordinance is passed and shall take effect upon first reading as an emergency measure this the 5th day of August, 1985.
