

**Ordinance No. 74**

IN ACCORDANCE WITH SUB CHAPTER C OF THE  
ELECTION CODE CHAPTER 2 PROVIDES FOR  
CANCELLATION OF CERTAIN ELECTIONS

WHEREAS, sub chapter C applies when "No place is contested" the election may be canceled.


The City Secretary hereby certifies to the City Council, all candidates are unopposed and;

WHEREAS: "no race is contested", the election may be canceled.


NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council hereby cancels the City General Election regularly scheduled for May 15, 2004.
